Processes 6,000 KLD of wastewater daily with no environmental discharge.

Enables advanced water reuse, closing the loop on wastewater with an eco-friendly water cycle.

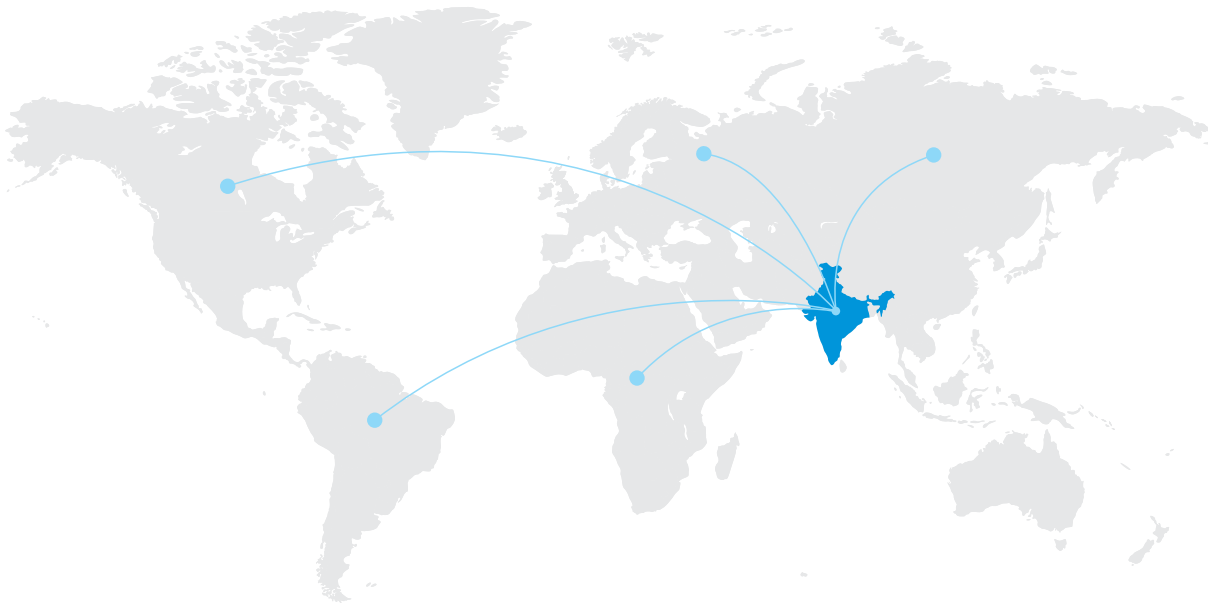
